This qualification is designed to meet the needs of tradesmen and managers of small to medium-sized building businesses, and is a requirement to obtain a Low Rise Builders Licence in Queensland. Builder licensing varies across states and territories and additional requirements to attainment of this qualification may be required.

You'll learn about standards and legal requirements; OHS; how to plan building construction work; conduct on-site supervision; apply structural principles and building codes, as well as gain business skills - such as how to manage small business finances. While there are no formal entry requirements for this qualification, it is highly recommended that you already hold a relevant trade qualification. Sound literacy and numeracy skills are recommended, and employment in the building and construction industry is essential.

COURSE METHOD & DURATION

This qualification is delivered flexibly over a period of up to 1 year. The duration may vary depending on your existing skills and knowledge and date of enrolment. Face to face classes are weekly from 5.00-7.00pm, days of delivery vary between campuses. Additional self-paced study is also required. The successful achievement of this qualification requires you to complete 16 units in total, including 13 core units and 3 elective units. Intakes are available throughout the year. Please register your interest to get the dates of the next available intake.

COST & PAYMENT

All Trades Queensland is a 'Pre- Qualified Supplier' under the Queensland Government Higher Level Skills Program. If you already hold a trade qualification (Certificate III) in the construction industry and you are a Queensland resident you may be eligible for funding. For Queensland Government Higher Level Skills participants non concession fee is \$496. Concession fee is \$304. If you are not eligible for funding the Full Fee for this program is \$4,992. While there are no formal entry requirements for this qualification, you must already hold a relevant trade qualification to be eligible for funding.

Please be aware that if undertaking this qualification fee for service (non-funded) a \$100.00 administration fee is required at time of enrolment. This fee is non refundable.

Higher Level Skills

This funding source is open to any Queensland resident aged 15 years or over who is no longer at school, does not hold or is currently undertaking a certificate IV or higher qualification and is an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
